## About

CollCom is a youth-driven Social Startup founded by research scholars of Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi. This social startup aims to connect College Campuses with the Community to inculcate civic responsibilities among youth. It is a non-profitable organisation registered on September 5, 2018 under India public Trust Act, established mainly to strengthen the National Service Scheme (NSS) units, NYKS, and other youth-led organisations in schools and colleges. It provides a platform and additional mentoring support for youth and corporate to work closely with community/villages such as street children, migrated people, slums, orphanage, old-age, safai-karamchari, divyang, drugs abused people, jail inmates, farmers and so on to understand their problems and need, and involve themselves in the problem-solving process, so that life of these people or villagers can be raised at higher material and moral level.

CollCom also connects all youth lead organisations at a single platform and provide the collective information, necessary supports, mentoring and training to the youth and youth-led organisations across the country. It is also certified with 12A and 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

## Vision

To make the world a better place to live and work, spread love and happiness, and create several opportunities.

## Mission

To create a platform for youths to discover their interest and inner potentials; guide, educate and maps their traits and talent in the right way of career, and develop a sense of civic responsibilities.

## Our Project

We have defined our project mainly in five dimensions. These projects have been briefly described below to understand the gist of the organisation objective.

1. **Education and Training:** Remedial Classes to the underprivileged students, development of self-learning library as well as a digital library, training, learning and dissemination of knowledge through sports and arts, skilled-based training, digital literacy, financial literacy, cybercrime awareness are some task of this project.
2. **Environment:** Understanding nature through a field trip, the sustainable approach of tree plantation, usage of the cycle for eco-friendly environment, waste segregation and decompose, rain harvesting, biogas production and use, solar energy awareness are some of the tasks we work on. 



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## **6. World Environment Day Celebration, two days national webinar on Impact of Covid-19 on Environment, held on June 5 and 6, 2020**

## 7. One Day National Workshop on "Cybercrime Awareness" held on June 7, 2020.

(Speaker: Dr Amit Singh (Scientist and Cyber Expert MeitY, Govt. of India, Session Chair: Dr Anil Kumar Singh, Ast Professor, Greek Chair, SLL&CS, JNU, and Advisory Board Member of CollCom)

### Brief overviews about the Event


The first national webinar of Cyber Crime Awareness was organised by CollCom in collaboration with the NSS unit of Awadh Centre of education (Institute of vocational studies), Jawaharlal Nehru University and Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri Rashtriya Sanskrit Vishwavidyalaya on June 7, 2020, at 4:00 PM.

The webinar was chaired by Dr Anil Kumar Singh (Greek Chair, SLL and CS, JNU, Advisory Member of CollCom). The chief guest was Dr Amit Singh (Scientist and Cyber expert MeitY, Govt. of India), who enlightened everyone about cybercrime. The webinar was conducted on the Zoom Video Conferencing App and broadcasted live on Facebook, where 900 users from all over India total.

Dr Amit Singh discussed the few popular topics of cybercrime such as Introduction to cybercrime, the emergence of India as a major centre of cybercrime, classification, preventive measures, cyber laws in India, incident reporting and different case study of income tax fraud, job fraud, PM care fund, UPI fraud. He guided us on how to be secure while being online and talked about the penalty and punishment one has to bear for committing cybercrime under the Indian cyber law. The

informative session created awareness and alarmed the audience for the need to exercise caution while using technology. It is a well-known fact that "Prevention is better than cure".

**Impact Created:** The webinar was organised through the Zoom app and broadcasted live on Facebook, where 1100+ participants from all over India joined and benefited from this workshop.



## **8. Cyber Champion Internship Inaugural Session on Cyber Crime & Security Awareness held on June 19, 2020**

(Chief Guest: Sri Kamal Kiskota, Regional Director of NSS-Delhi, Speaker: Dr Amit Kumar, NSS Programme Coordinator, JNU, Dr Prem Singh Sirkarwar, NSS Programme Coordinator, SLBSNSU, and Session Chair: Dr Anil Kumar Singh, Ast Prof, Greek Chair, JNU and Advisory Member of CollCom)

### **Brief overviews about the Event**

Dr Gaurav Kumar (Director of CollCom) briefed everyone about the role of CollCom, a College Community network, which provides a platform for the youth of India who are associated with organisations such as NSS and NYKS etc, to hone their talents which can be put to use for the betterment of the society.


Then, Dr Anil Kumar Singh mentioned the importance of cyberspace in today's world. He said how communication had become the centre of everything, and it is easily achievable through the cyber world. However, there is a dark side to it, too, because one needs to be highly aware of this cyber world. Keeping this in mind, he stated the importance of such an internship which deals with a contemporary topic like this one. He further motivated the students by calling them "Cyber Soldiers" ready to spread awareness on such an important topic.



Dr Prem Singh. (Asst Professor, NSS Coordinator, Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University, New Delhi) talked about the importance of cybersecurity in our day to day life. He highlighted the role of China in being a source of cyber hacking today. Giving a statistical view, he emphasised on the majorly affected states by cybercrime issue such as Maharashtra (21%) is leading with the highest number of cybercrimes followed by Delhi (15.2%), W. Bengal (12.8), Gujarat (10.6%), Uttar Pradesh (9.5%), Karnataka (8.7%), Rajasthan (8%), Tamil Nadu (7.3%), Madhya Pradesh (6.9%), Telangana, etc. According to the 1985 data, the cybercrime incidents in India was 17.5% in 1915, 75% in 2016, 79% in 2017, 77.2% in 2018 and 78% in 2019 related to cyberbullying, Email hack, Banking Account hack and password hacks reported. Fraud Emails, SMS and calls, various games (like a Blue whale), pornographic content, and files on smartphones intended to hack our systems and banking information are increasing at an alarming rate. He further talked about the Electronic cyberbullying on computer, smartphones, laptops and technology used to bully a person. Banking frauds and fraud job positions on different social media platforms are cybercrimes. The military security agency is alert even though the information sometimes hacked.

He reiterated himself and ended his speech by asking the volunteers to take advantage of such an internship to sensitise the people with cyber-crime threats.

Dr Amit Kumar (Asst Professor, NSS Coordinator, Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi, elaborated on the evolution of information technology worldwide, emphasising India in the last 15 years. He talked about the importance of the Internet that became a necessary life structure in the previous two decades. He focused on increasing Internet and mobile applications by youth as Jio provided low-cost internet services and Jio Phone availability in India. Undoubtedly, internet facility created tons of opportunities in education, telecommunication, travel, e-commerce, etc. The opportunities come with a cost and limit the usage of the sources. He discussed the "Instagram-Boys Locker Room" case as a threat to the harmony of society. He was also focused on the availability of pornographic content to the kids that can cause harm to social protection, even another component related to the economy like cyber frauds for the demand for money. The cyber-crime issue is not just a personal issue but now has become a national security issue. Thus, understanding how the usage of Chinese applications is leading to a compromise to national security. A better understanding of such complex structure and functions and ways to protect self from such substantial threats by volunteers and create awareness of the issue to the local people to better society.



The session was concluded by Ms Abhivyakti (NSS JNU Convener) by informing everyone about the Stop Cyber Bullying Day celebration every 3<sup>rd</sup> Friday of June. Launched by Cyber Smile Foundation in 2012, this day encourages people worldwide to show commitment towards a truly inclusive and diverse online environment.

## 9. Two days national webinar on Connecting With Self, held on July 7 and 8, 2020


CollCom organised a two-day National Webinar in collaboration with the National Service Scheme, Jawaharlal Nehru University and Vivekananda Kendra Kanyakumari, New Delhi, on the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> of July. This webinar was an effort towards empowering the youth to bring their potentialities into actuality, revolving around the theme "**Connecting with Self.**"

The Inaugural ceremony of this National Webinar took place on July 7, 2020, and the session focused on "Swami Vivekananda's Message for the Youth." Prof Rana Pratap Singh chaired the inaugural session, Rector -III Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi. Professor Singh beautifully summed up Swami Vivekananda's message to the youth and mentioned that his contributions to society are voluminous though he didn't live for long. He emphasised Swami's message of sacrifice and selfless service, working for the underprivileged, his ideologies of Nishkamakarma, unity as the basis for ethics, and not wasting energy in focusing on trivialities in life, among others.



The guest speaker for the Session, Mr Nikhil Yadav, Prant Yuva Pramukh, Uttar Prant, Vivekananda Kendra, Kanyakumari, New Delhi, addressed the gathering. Mr Yadav began with Swami Ji's definition of youth as the one who has "muscles of iron, nerves of steel and mind like a thunderbolt". He went on to talk about the ideology of taking up one idea, rejecting several other paths and striving to conquer the chosen one. Whatever is achieved in one's life is due to the

amalgamation of external forces and one's own contribution. Since external forces are beyond our control, one should work hard to enhance his or her own contribution to achieving success.



Mr Yadav also emphasised "Worship through service", the importance of "universal acceptance over universal tolerance" and the necessity of Indianisation of western concepts for the devenation's development. He concluded by requesting the youth to have a purpose in life which is a prerequisite for one's existence.

The second day of the webinar began with the same flavour. It revolved around the topic of **"Mindful Breathing."** Speaker Mr Nikhil Yadav, taking forward his zeal to inspire the youth, talked about yoga's association with Indian culture since the times of the Indus Valley civilisation. Swami Vivekananda was instrumental in taking this to the world. The present testing times of the pandemic have brought to the forefront the problem of depression, anxiety etc. which has an invariable association with one's inner self. He further mentioned that our selfishness pushes us into the vicious cycle of stress. Physically, we are a tiny part of the cosmos; therefore, one needs to go beyond one's body and focus on the inner self. This insightful lecture was followed by several rounds of mindful breathing exercises such as alternative Breathing, also known as "Vishisht-ta, Kapal Bhati," "AnulomVilom," "NadiShudhu" "Shitli" and sectional Breathing. These exercises, as was told by Mr Yadav help us in taking control over ourselves, our mind, our body and our soul. It is very important to control oneself to live a healthy life and not fall under the trap of depression and anxiety. We can manage them.

This 2-day Event saw the whopping participation of around 1500 youth from different parts of the nation **connected through Zoom and Facebook live. It was smoothly moderated by** Abhivyakti Vivek, Convener, National Service Scheme, Jawaharlal Nehru University, and Dr Gaurav Kumar, Director of the vote of thanks CollCom.


### **Brief overviews about the Event**

## **Brief overviews about the Event**



**18. A national webinar on "Swami Vivekananda's Message of Universal Brotherhood: Impact and Relevance" held on September 13, 2020, at 11 AM**

Speaker: Dr. Rajesh Kumar Dwivedi, Associate Professor, University of Delhi.

On September 13 2020, Vivekananda Rock Memorial & Vivekananda Kendra, Vasant Kunj Vistar in Collaboration with CollCom (College Community), organised a webinar on Swami Vivekananda's Message of Universal Brotherhood: Impact and Relevance. Dr. Rajesh started

talking about Swami Vivekananda and significantly contributed to the religion and social reform movement. He always used the term universal religion, and with the help of this, he thought of establishing universal brotherhood. After facing various incidents of discrimination based on colour, caste etc, he came across his Guru Sri Ramakrishna Paramhansa realised the greatness of all religions. Vivekananda imbibed this influence and, at a very young age, formed an association and decided to practice brotherhood in our lives. He said, "We must show the spirituality of the Hindus, mercifulness of Buddhists, the activity of Christians, the brotherhood of Mohammedans, by our practical lives. After the death of his guru, he travelled to different parts of the country and met many people, rich or poor and the philosophy of Advaita, which he learned, influenced him a lot. Another incident happened when he was staying at the king's place, and a singer was coming to perform. At that time, singers didn't have much status; they were considered prostitutes. She wanted to take the blessings of Vivekananda, but he withdrew himself away from her. She understood what happened and starting singing a song

She explains that iron may be there in a temple or at a butcher's shop; it may be used for cutting animals or be worshipped, but is it the mistake or the iron? In the same way, is it my mistake if I was born in that family and had to choose this profession? Is it my mistake? Did I commit any sin? That's when Vivekananda realised his mistake and failed to see divinity in that singer.



He realised discussing and applying philosophies are two different things. In another incident, Vivekananda proudly said, "I am proud to belong to a religion that has taught the world both tolerance and universal acceptance. We believe not only in universal toleration, but we accept all religions as true. I am proud to belong to a nation which has sheltered the persecuted and the refugees of all religions and all nations of the earth."

"As different streams having different sources all mingle their waters in the sea, so different tendencies, various though they appear, crooked or straight, all lead to God." No matter what your religious beliefs are, everyone will meet at the same in the end. Vivekananda always talked about the greatness of all religions in the world. He used a metaphor of "a frog in the well" and said that every person thinks that their religion is the best and the greatest of all. He then said that I am a Hindu, sitting in my little well and thinking that the whole world is my well; Christian sits in his little well and thinks that's the entire world and so on. This is the reason why they expect people to convert or get killed. Vivekananda said that universal brotherhood doesn't mean that your identity will be lost; you will be a Muslim forever if you are a Muslim. Accept brotherhood; that's the only way to establish peace.

Sometimes it's better to dream a dream than to die on hard facts. Wondrous truths, even in a dream, are better than wrong facts so let us dream a dream. It is challenging to transform it into reality; that's what life is about. He passed away, but we still see his vision.


Sir William Tarn justifiably assumed that the son of Bindusara, Ashoka, who established Buddhism as the official religion in the Maurya Empire, could have been half Greek.
